

PRIVACY STATEMENT

Prionet BV respects the privacy of the visitors to its website, in particular the rights of visitors with regard to the automated processing of personal data. Because of full transparency with our customers we have therefore formulated and implemented a policy in relation to these processing operations themselves, their purpose as well as the possibilities for the rights of those involved to be exercised as well as possible.

Article 1 - Legal provisions

Article 2 - Access to the website

- Access to the website and use is strictly personal. You will not use this website as well as the data and information provided thereon for commercial, political or advertising purposes, or for any commercial offers and in particular do not use the website for unsolicited electronic offers.

Article 3 - The content of the website

Article 4 - Management of the website

 - suspend, interrupt or restrict access to a certain category of visitors to all or part of the website
 - remove any information that may interfere with the functioning of the website or is in violation of national or international legislation or is contrary to internet etiquette
 - have the website temporarily unavailable in order to be able to carry out updates

Article 5 – Responsibilities

- The manager is in no way responsible for failure, malfunctions, difficulties or interruptions of the functioning of the website, making the website or one of its functionalities not accessible. The way in which you seek to connect to the website is your own responsibility. You must take all appropriate measures to protect your equipment and your data against, among other things, virus attacks on the internet.  - because of violating the conditions of this privacy policy

- If the manager becomes involved in a dispute as a result of your use of this website, he is entitled to recover from you any damage that he suffers as a result of which he will suffer.

Article 6 - Collection of data

- Your data is collected by Prionet BV. Personal data is considered to be all information about an identified or identifiable natural person; to be identifiable is considered a natural person who can be identified directly or indirectly, in particular on the basis of an identifier such as a name, an identification number, location data, an online identifier or one or more elements that are characteristic of the physical, physiological, genetic, psychological, economic, cultural or social identity.
- The personal data collected on the website are mainly used by the manager for maintaining relations with you and if necessary for the processing of your orders.

Article 7 - Your rights with regard to your data

- Pursuant to Article 13 paragraph 2 sub b AVG (GDPR) everyone has the right to inspect and rectify or the deletion of their personal data or restriction of the processing concerning them, as well as the right to object to the processing and the right to data portability. - Any request for this must be accompanied by a copy of a valid proof of identity, on which you have placed your signature and stating the address to which you can be contacted. You will receive a reply to your request within 1 month of the submitted request. Depending on the complexity of the requests and the number of requests, this period can, if necessary, be extended by 2 months.

Article 8 - Processing of personal data

- In the event of violation of any law or regulation, which the visitor is suspected of and for which the authorities need personal data collected by the administrator, these will be provided to them after an explicit and motivated request from those authorities, after which this personal data will no longer be under the protection of the provisions of this privacy statement.
- If certain information is necessary to gain access to certain functionalities of the website, the controller will indicate the mandatory nature of this information at the time of requesting the data.

Article 9 - Commercial offers

- If you encounter any personal data during the visit of the website, you must refrain from collecting them or from any other unauthorized use as well as from any act that gives rise to a violation of the personal privacy of that (or those) person(s). Article 10 - Storage period data

- The data collected by the website administrator are used and stored for the duration as determined by law.

Article 11 - Cookies

- A cookie is a small text file that is placed on the hard disk when visiting our website from your computer. A cookie contains data so that you can visit every visitor to our website as a visitor be recognized. It is then possible to set up our website specifically for you and to log in easily.
